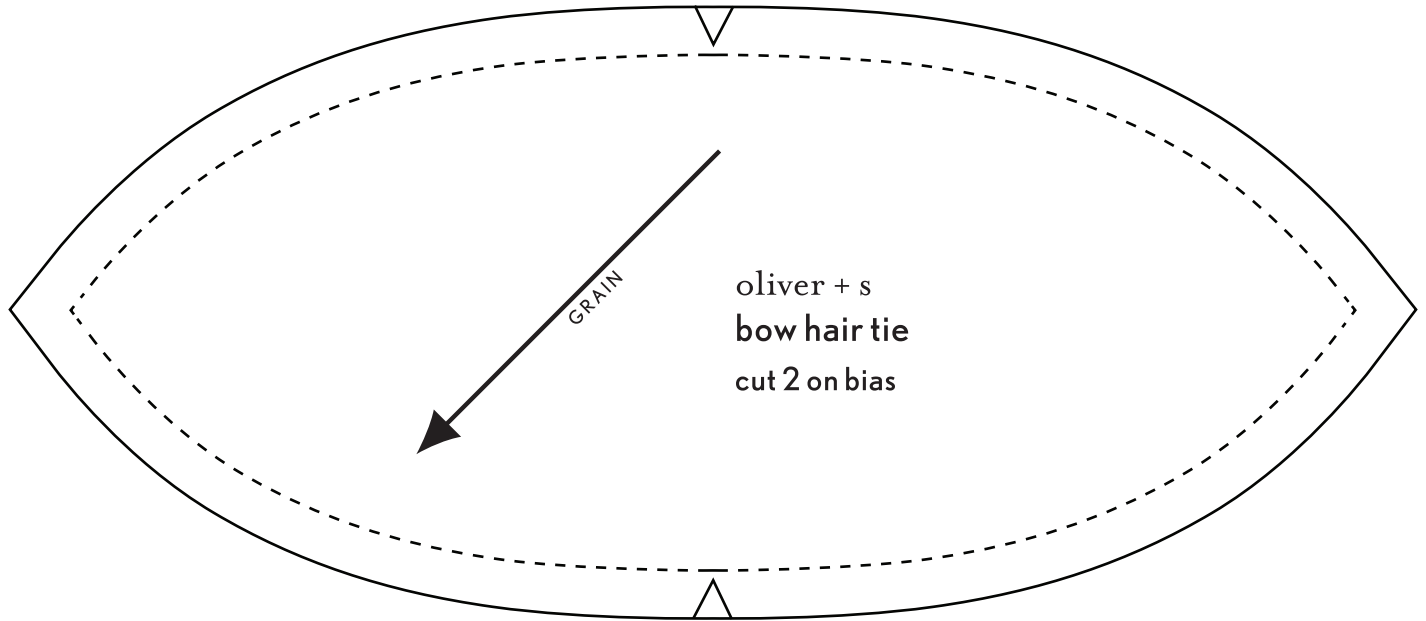


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# BOW HAIR TIE



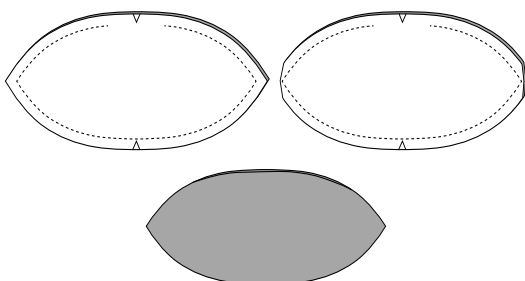
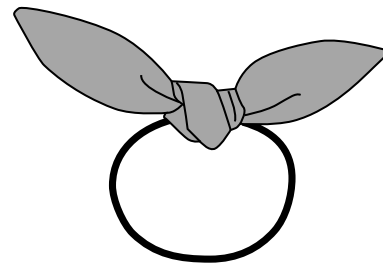
## SUPPLIES

- 2 scraps of fabric, each approximately 5" x 5"
- 1 elastic hair tie
- coordinating thread

## TO MAKE THE BOW

1. Pin the two cut bow pieces together with right sides facing and the notches matching. Stitch around edge with a 1/4" seam, leaving a 1 1/2" - to 2" - long opening near the center and pivoting at the corners. Trim the corners, and turn the bow right side out through the opening. Press the sewn edges, tucking the seam allowances at the opening inside so the curves are smooth.

2. Tie the bow in a single knot around a hair elastic. The knot will keep the opening shut so you don't need to hand sew it closed. Enjoy!



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
